OUR MISSION


The Johnson Ohana Charitable Foundation is a non-profit public charity founded in 2008 by Jack and Kim Johnson to promote positive and lasting change within communities by supporting organizations that focus on environmental, art, and music education.

2013 HIGHLIGHTS

In 2013, Jack Johnson toured in support of his newest album, From Here To Now To You, while continuing to build momentum for the All At Once community of Non-Profit Partners. The Johnson Ohana Charitable Foundation distributed \$202,939 in direct and matching donations to over 90 non-profit groups throughout Europe, North America, New Zealand and Australia, focusing on plastic free initiatives and sustainable local food systems, as well as environmental education and other hands-on community projects.

In addition to All At Once donations made to environmental organizations, the Johnson Ohana Charitable Foundation offered grants to support environmental, art and music education over two grantmaking cycles, distributing over \$345,00 in 2013.
